Now the number of militant feminists are increasing that most suffer from inequality in genders like drawing the line in learning, discriminating and taking a great responsibility on the child-rearing whilst men are in charge of providing them with all facilities. Everyone has their personal view towards this notion.

Most girls in India, Turkey and Bangladesh are out of school and most of these countries are poor in developing. Many have the view of prohibiting girls to go schools, instead they persuade their daughters to do household chores and preparing for marriage as they are burden for their family and one day they, undoubtedly, do the marriage, so" feeding" them is the responsibility of their husbands. Plus, "fathers" see their sons as legal heirs since they are upcoming breadwinners, providing food and shelter of them. Turning to selling girls off, it reached its peak mostly in Afghanistan and what is written on the forehead is to be slave or give a birth from their early age. In some countries we hear even the matter of sexual exploitation that most teenage girls get letters from boys and following behind them, resulting in attracting (flirting) each other and having sex.

By contrast, it is observed that if a girl is well-educated, she is less likely to be trusted to violent intended people and the rate of young marriage is going on in a quite slow motion. When concluding all of these matters, it is only due to barriers of lack of opportunity and permission to attain knowledge.

This mission was accomplished in some places but not modernized sites -no access to the Internet, no electricity and wall made from bamboo trees which leads to noisy environment. However, the next challenge was the deficiency of qualified instructors which means that the smartest student of 5-6th grades were not even close its degree, even though the bitter sweats parents were doing too much to make sure that they are well educated and not living below the poverty line.

A long time ago, there was a matriarchal system that tribes were manipulated by women and today women are taking steps to protect their rights to study or nurture children together and even work like men. Until when they continue shouldering in men's hands and remaining confined to the four walls of the house? If the husband passes away where do they go? So, allowing acquiring knowledge to females does work in this case. If the educated women's opinions are supported solving problems would be easier as most of them are self reliant and able to make decisions wisely.

In most countries, especially in Japan, in an effort to support gender equality they pass a law of taking paternal leave of 7 months to upbringing a child together. In this case both of them can benefit in boosting their business skills and widening the relationship with children. While father are exercising or walking with children mother have the choice of training in their work. At first due to masculinity-the urge to not do the tasks that women are supposed to do- of fathers they did not accept this leave, but now the proportion of taking it is increasing and more than 90 percent of Japanese female students are craving to take parental leave and spend time together.

In the past, looking down to females was as natural as slavish treatment. They do not have the right of participating in marathons, as they had rumors of running a marathon would harm their health. Besides, eating much smaller portions at meal times than their brothers that they are "male" or making them to dismiss from jury duty only due to less performance of domestic duties?

In one study, 30 percent of women successfully was able to get a job as an orchestra if the arbiter would not be informed that it is the female as they had the idea of approaching men. In another one, a team won in a competition, reason was not due to there were men been brilliant minds but ladies participation on that. Today, in most places we are likely to find women in selections or marathon runners, even winner on that and owners of Noble Prize or president of the country. Although most countries are in the back stage in women equality they also may advance these theories and most problems will be automatically solved.

Looking at the religion of Islam, rights of weaker sexes were formed so many years ago(600 CE). In some circumstances we could observe husbands forcing their wife transfer of the land ownership, but the religion ban this violence that
