The current Law "On Education" was adopted 22 years ago. In order to improve the draft law, the responsible committees and working groups of the Legislative Chamber and Senate of the Oliy Majlis held several discussions. As a result, the new version of the Law "On Education" was adopted by the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis on May 19, 2020. It was approved by the Senate on August 7 of this year.

main part: With the signing of this Law by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev on September 23, 2020, the effective August 29, 1997 "On Education" and "National Personnel Training Program" Laws "on" have lost their force. Regardless of social status, everyone is guaranteed equal rights to education.

Types of education include:

- preschool education and upbringing;
- general secondary and secondary special education;
- professional education;
- higher education;
- post-higher education;
- retraining of personnel and improvement of their qualifications;

extracurricular education. preschool education and upbringing is a type of education aimed at teaching and educating children, developing them intellectually, morally, ethically, aesthetically and physically, as well as preparing children for general secondary education. general secondary and secondary special education is aimed at mastering general educational programs, necessary

knowledge, qualifications and skills. General secondary education includes grades I-XI. secondary special education is carried out for 2 years on the basis of 9-year basic secondary education in academic lyceums and provides rapid development of intellectual abilities of students, as well as deep, differentiated, career- and personality-oriented education provides receiving. professional education is divided into primary professional education, secondary professional education and secondary special professional education levels.

Primary professional education is carried out free of charge on the basis of 2-year integrated program of general education subjects and specialized subjects in the form of full-time education on the basis of IX grade graduates in vocational schools. general secondary, secondary special education and primary It is carried out on the basis of internal professional education.

Research shows that competencies "are the expected and measurable achievements of a person, which determine what a person can do after the completion of the educational process; for the successful activity of a specialist in a certain professional field, all his potential (knowledge, skillsexperience and personal qualities) a generalized feature that determines readiness for use. .based on the above definitions, it is possible to present the important content of the concept of "professional competence", which is considered in acmeology in its department of developmental psychology as the main cognitive component of the subsystems of human professional skills and higher professional activityperform productively.the structure and content of professional powers are mainly determined by the specific characteristics of professional activity, its belonging to certain types.

Analyzing the essence of the concept of "professional competence", it reflects the ability of a teacher (teacher) to effectively implement professional activities and achieve goals related to personal development in the preschool education system, knowledge, experience and professionalallows to present as an integration of important personal qualities.and this is possible if the subject of professional activity achieves a certain level of professionalismProfessionalism in psychology and acmeology is a high level of readiness to perform the tasks of professional activity, a qualitative characteristic of the subject of work, reflecting high professional skills and qualifications, various effective professional skills and abilities, including creative solutionsDemonstrates mastery of modern algorithms and solutions.professional tasks that allow for the implementation of activities with high and stable productivity.

Secondary special professional education is carried out in technical schools on the basis of a state order or a payment contract in the form of full-time, evening and part-time education with a duration of at least 2 years.

Higher education ensures the training of highly qualified personnel in bachelor's and master's specialties. Training of highly educated personnel is carried out in higher education organizations (universities, academies, institutes, higher schools).

Higher education has two levels - undergraduate and master's level. Baccalaureate is a basic higher education that provides in-depth knowledge, qualifications and skills in one of the directions of higher education, and the duration of study is at least 3 years.

A master's degree is a higher education with a duration of at least 1 year of study in a specific specialty on the basis of a relevant bachelor's degree. Post-graduate education can be obtained in higher education and scientific organizations. post-higher education, which involves in-depth study of the specialty and conducting scientific research in order to prepare and defend a doctoral dissertation, scientific and scientific-pedagogical with a scientific degree on the basis of doctoral studies and independent research provides personnel training, retraining of personnel and improvement of their qualifications. Retraining of personnel ensures the acquisition of the necessary amount of additional professional knowledge, qualifications and skills to carry out activities in accordance with basic specialties and professions.
